

BEE COUNTY JUNIOR LIVESTOCK & HOMEMAKERS SHOW 2025 Queen Contest

Dear Duchess and Countess Contestant,

We are delighted to have you as a participant in the 2025 BCJLHS Queens Contest! We are so excited for this year! Each club may have an unlimited number of representatives in each of the 4 categories:

Queen contestants (grades 9-12)

Princess contestants (grades 6–8)

Duchess contestants (grades 3-5)

Countess contestants (grades K-2)

The objective of the BCJLHS Queen's Contest is to promote confidence and leadership skills by encouraging community service, leadership skills, and public speaking. Queen and Princess Contestants will receive points in three divisions and be crowned on stage during the contest. Countess and Duchess Contestants will not be judged, put simply will gain onstage confidence and experience for the future!

Criteria

- 1. All contestants MUST be enrolled in a 4-H, FFA, or FCCLA club/chapter AND all Countess contestants must be actively enrolled in the Bee County Young Exhibitors.
- 2. Contestants must attend ALL mandatory meetings on the following dates. If at any time you miss one of the mandatory meetings you may not be eligible for the contest.
 - December 8 Orientation Meeting 1pm at Methodist Church.
 - January 2 Rehearsal 1pm @ CBC Auditorium
 - January 3 Contest 6:30pm @ CBC Auditorium
- 3. Contestants must be passing by the December 13, 2024 UIL eligibility date in order to participate in the contest. An eligibility form will be due on December 20, 2024
- 4. Contestants may not have any ISS/DAEP referrals from August through December of the current school year. Eligibility will be assessed on the entry form and again on the eligibility form
- 5. Each contestant must enter a minimum of 1 project in the 2025 BCJLHS
- 6. Each contestant must participate in 1 community service activity
- 7. Each contestant must participate in fundraising efforts by selling a minimum of 20 50/50 Raffle tickets (\$100 worth)

First, you must complete the Queen's Contest entry form and submit payment to the Bee County Texas A&M Agrilife Extension office by 12:00 pm on November 1st, 2024. This is a hard deadline as t-shirts and sashes must be ordered by that weekend. The entry fee is \$50 for Duchess and Countess contestants.

A mandatory orientation meeting will be held on Sunday, December 8th at 1:00 p.m. at the Methodist Church Welcome Center, 106 Cleveland St., Beeville. You and a parent or guardian, MUST attend the Orientation meeting. Parents and contestants will be required to stay for the meeting and photos. We will pass out the contestant t-shirts and sashes at this meeting and take Head Shot and group photos.

Each contestant is required to participate in at least 1 of the community service activity. Duchess and Countess contestants must bring toiletries to the orientation meeting - must bring 5 travel sized toiletries and 5 single non-perishable food items (can goods, single serving granola bars, peanut butter crackers, etc) to meet the community service criteria.

Each contestant is required to participate in the contest fundraising efforts by selling a minimum of 20 (\$100) 50/50 raffle tickets. These will be distributed at the orientation meeting and will be turned in at the rehearsal. If the minimum 20 tickets are not sold, the contestant will not be eligible to participate in the contest.

And finally, The Contest!! The Duchess and Countess contestants will introduce themselves on stage, and participate in a group line dance. The theme is "Wild, Wild West" with emerald green, black, gold and browns being the primary colors – in case you want to start outfit shopping!

All contestants must meet all of requirements previously listed. If you are not willing to participate in all these areas, then you will want to reconsider. We are looking for the best young ladies to represent Bee County and the show! We look forward to working with you!
